Never Give Out Your Personal Information

- Do not share your Medicare number, Social Security number, or other personal information with anyone who contacts you unsolicited.

Be Ware of Unsolicited Calls and Emails

- If you receive a call or email claiming to be from Medicare, hang up or delete the message and contact Medicare directly to verify the legitimacy of the communication.

Review Your Medicare Statements

- Regularly review your Medicare statements for any suspicious activity.


Be Cautious of Unsolicited Offers

- Do not accept offers for "free" Medicare plans or prescription drugs.

Report Suspicious Activity

- If you suspect that you have been a victim of Medicare fraud, report it to the appropriate authorities.
